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How to Select a Private Label Dietary Supplement Contract Manufacturer



Given the increasingly regulated nature of the dietary supplement industry, outsourcing manufacturing and packaging is a common practice globally. However, how does one go about selecting a qualified and reliable contract manufacturer?

Obviously, price is going to be a huge determinant. Aside from price, several significant factors must be considered especially in today's market: (1) regulatory compliance (2) lead-times; and (3) scalability.

Regulatory compliance requires a significant investment in state-of-the-art manufacturing facilities. This includes HEPA filtered clean rooms, technologically advanced stainless steel equipment, thoroughly documented and comprehensive procedures, and fully-equipped laboratory facilities. The purpose of all these investments is to assure product purity and potency. Also important is the manufacturer's ability to provide the necessary documentation, especially for export. Short, yet reasonable lead-times are also necessary for a successful relationship with a contract manufacturer. Lead-times must be short enough to meet the demands of supply chain and market trends. However, lead-times must also be long enough to allow the manufacturer to conduct the necessary quantitative and qualitative tests necessary to ensure purity and potency. Expect anywhere from eight to twelve weeks.

Scalability is important especially if your business is growing. Choose a manufacturer that has the necessary infrastructure to meet your growth projections. Most contract manufacturers operate below capacity. Make sure they have the physical and financial capital necessary to grow with your marketing efforts.

Summarily, finding the right contract manufacturer and outsourcing your manufacturing can save in variable unit costs, increased regulatory pressures, and financial and managerial resources necessary to operate a GMP compliant factory profitably. Relationships are based on mutual trust and communication. Make sure you can trust your contract manufacturer to comply with the changing regulatory environment to provide you cost-effective private label products and analytical services. ■
